


Sawaguchi riverside small kamakura lighting

Lighting days / Only on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays during the period

Lighting time / 5:30 p.m.-9:00 p.m. **Entrance Fee / Free**

When the lights are lit in the mini kamakura, a fantastic night view spreads out.





Yunishigawa Mizunosato Snow Park

Period / January 28 - February 25, 2024 Business hours / 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. (Last reception 2:00 p.m.)

Entrance Fee / 1,200 yen for adults, 600 yen for children (including sledding fee and hot spring bathing fee at Mizunosato. The hot springs open from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., last reception 6:00 p.m.)

You can enjoy sledding and playing in the snow, which is unique to a snowy country. The shop sells hot snacks and drinks.

If you get too cold, you can warm up your body and soul by soaking in the hot springs.

Business Hours /9:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m. (last entry 8:45 p.m.)

Small Kamakura light-up / 5:30 p.m.-9:00

Entrance Fee / 1-day ticket (9:00 a.m.-9:00 p.m.): 510 yen for adults, 250 yen for elementary and junior high school students (re-entry possible on the day)

You can see small kamakura and big kamakura in the park, which is dotted with old folk houses with snow-covered thatched roofs.
